Physical Space, Staff and Educational Materials

GOAL & GAIN

1. Comprehend basic processing techniques to perform EMR and ESD procedures in the in vivo models

2. Regarding the EMR, ESD and POEM techniques;

- Mucosal marking
- Submucosal injections and solutions
- Mucosal incision
- Submucosal dissection
- Tunnel creation for POEM, precise myotomy, closing a tunnel using appropriate closing techniques
- Hemostasis
- Resecting the lesion
- Sending the sample to pathological examination
- 3. Gain experience in the key technologies supporting good ESD practice.
- 4. Understand the aspects and practices required to establish an ESD unit.
- 5. A Certificate of Participation will be given to those who complete the program.
